We carry out informal checks and engage with suppliers directly to ensure there is no known risk of modern slavery, forced labour, or human trafficking. If concerns are raised, we are prepared to take appropriate action, including ending relationships with non-compliant partners and suppliers.

Training and Awareness

We will ensure any team members are made aware of the risks of modern slavery and how to identify potential signs of abuse or exploitation.

Future Steps

We are committed to continuous improvement and will review our practices annually to ensure we are doing our part in preventing modern slavery.
