Commitment to Net Zero

Carbon Nil Medical is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions across Scopes 1, 2 and 3 by 2045, and becoming Carbon Negative at the earliest opportunity.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Carbon Nil Medical began trading in September 2025, so does not yet have 12 months of data to set its first baseline. We will publish our first full Carbon Reduction Plan as soon as possible following the completion of our first trading year.

Emission Reduction Targets

Carbon Nil Medical is committed to building a long-term carbon negative business that actively supports and aligns with the NHS goal to become the world's first net zero national health service.

We have committed to a long-term target of net zero across our operations and value chain by 2045. This equates to an absolute reduction in emissions of at least 90% against our baseline, which will remain under review annually as we grow. Our emissions reporting will be verified by an expert third party.

We will also maintain carbon neutrality for Scope 1 and 2 emissions, and longer-term become carbon negative across all emissions Scopes. This means emissions removals must exceed emissions generated each year.

All of our current and future targets will meet the requirements of the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi)'s 1.5C emissions pathway, to ensure we are always aligned with best practice action on climate change.



Carbon Reduction Projects

We are committed to taking action to bring down our emissions in-line with our near-term and long-term targets.

We have already completed or are currently working on the below measures. We will continue to develop our carbon reduction strategy once our emissions baseline is established.

<p>Fully remote operations</p> <p>Our team work remotely to minimize, and avoid when possible, any emissions associated with day-to-day operations and travel. All members of the team work from home on 100% renewable energy tariffs.</p>	<p>Business Travel, Employee Commuting</p>
<p>Digital promotion</p> <p>We expect the majority of our promotion to be 90-95% through virtual calls and meetings, and digital promotion to minimise unnecessary travel. This will be measured and reported publicly on our website.</p> <p>When travel is required, we will endeavor to travel by electric car and/or will offset the journey through high quality emission removal projects.</p>	<p>Business Travel</p>
<p>Supplier engagement</p> <p>The majority of our Scope 3 emissions are likely to be generated in our supply chain. We endeavour to work with suppliers and partners who share our sustainability ambitions.</p> <p>Wherever possible, companies we partner with will be required to have a Carbon Reduction Plan in place that complies with NHS Evergreen level one at minimum. We will provide support to those who need it, utilising our in-house sustainability expertise and external partners.</p>	<p>Purchased Goods and Services</p>
